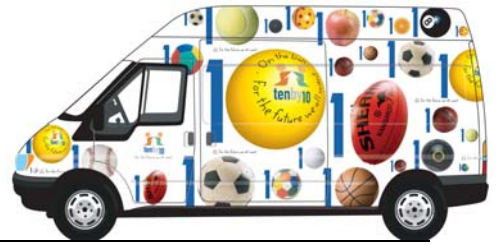


On The Ball For Tenby10



Community Van Background & Guidelines:

A tenby10 van – “On the Ball for ten by 10” – has been developed to assist in the delivery of tenby10 information and updates to the Port Pirie Community.

The van is a mobile information/education display unit and will be available to attend highly patronised events and locations throughout the community thus ensuring tenby10 information is delivered in the most accessible and engaging way possible.

The van will provide an avenue for the community to readily access information and communicate directly with the key tenby10 project stakeholders eg Port Pirie Regional Council, Environmental Health Service, Port Pirie Regional Health Service, Dept of Health, Nyrstar, Environmental Protection Authority, and CANdo.

All requests for the tenby10 van must be in writing and submitted to the Stakeholder Relations Office at Nyrstar. Attendance at an event will be judged against the following criteria;

- Does the event reflect the tenby10 project goal, which is to lower blood lead within the Port Pirie Community.
- Will the event enable access to groups within the community who can assist/have an impact on lowering children's blood lead.
- Will the event engage and build goodwill within the community towards the tenby10 project.
- Does the event enable access to those children within the projects target group (0-4 years of age).
- Does the event enable access to parents/carers who may need assistance in minimising a child's exposure to sources of lead contamination
- Does the event contribute to a functional and vibrant local community

Attendance will **not** be considered at those events that;

- Support local, state or federal political parties, individuals or campaigns
- Associate with groups or individuals who may harm the reputation of the tenby10 project or the key stakeholder group – the Port Pirie Regional Council, the Dept of Health, the Environment Protection Authority and Nyrstar.
- Do not reflect the tenby10 project partner's visions and values.
- Alcohol will be sold/available

Once consideration has been given to the request, the nominated event organiser will be contacted. A letter confirming attendance or non-attendance at the event will also be forwarded to the event organiser.

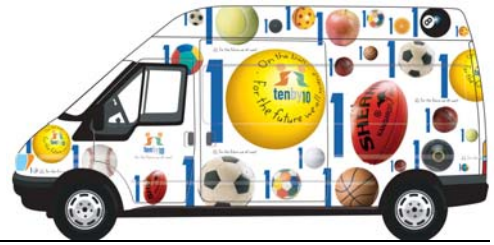
