Outstanding actions from May minutes

- Suggestion: To invite a member of HAC (Health Advisory Council) to attend CANdo meetings/join CANdo. **Action: Lucy** to follow up.
- Suggestion: Targeted tenby10 awareness/compliance issues to landlords and tenants. eg. Compliance on renting out homes that allow lead dust to enter through window frames and roof/ceilings, have backyards of open dirt. Are Tenants ‘tenby10 issues’ rights covered? **Karen to follow up with John Roeters on how this went at the Working Party meeting.**

At the May Working Party meeting this is what they had to say about the Air Purifier from their minutes.... “6. Air purifier identified by CanDo - This particular unit has been looked at and trialled by the Department of Health. Works well in a small confined area and only has a local effect in the region of the machine. To be effective you would need 2 or 3 units per room to reduce the total loading”

- Q: Ideas please on the best way to communicate with pregnant women. Who are they, what kind of messaging? Help and advice on keeping blood lead levels low. Communication via give-a-way packs? Suggested: pre-natal/ante-natal classes. Mums groups (ECIG).
- Ideas/suggestion: paper hand wipes to have printed messages re tenby10 in public toilets.
- Q: Are people still taking notice of the TV ads, CANdo put your feelers out, ask around. Are people finding the ads useful etc.
- Suggestion: next TVC to be similar to Bootometer on tenby10 website – more cartoon orientated, fun
- It was noticed that blowers are used to clean the front entrance to the hospital. Is this good tenby10 practice?
- CANdo logo: Greenteam to followup on what that may look like.
- CANdo minutes to go onto tenby10 website. **Action: Karen** to follow up
- Pirie Go Green: Anne Mathews presents idea. Suggestion for Anne to develop a team of people/committee to discuss. Also discuss with Jean Smith from Council, Event Management specialist.
- Q: is cost of excess water precluding people from using it. Ok to have extra time to water, but will people on lower incomes use this if it costs them too much?
